- Ability to work well with others, cultivate a team-building atmosphere, and nurture relationships with co-workers and Serve Team Members
- Ability to manage a calendar of events, task list, work schedules, and multiple responsibilities simultaneously
- Ability to perform job requirements in a high-energy and fast-paced environment
- Willingness and ability to work nontraditional hours on nights and weekends as needed, understanding the ins-and-outs of a ministry-conscious environment
- Ability to maintain confidentiality and discretion in pastoral/ministry interactions

Essential Functions and Responsibilities

 Be the main point person for all things Purpose YTH. This includes but isn't limited to the following:

Leadership

- Create a place where leaders who are passionate about Jesus and students can serve and make a difference.
- o Continually pour into leaders to help them grow in their spiritual walk, as well as their own personal development.
- Make at least one point of contact (POC) per week with a leader on the team to check-in and encourage.
- Find and develop your "person" for a season who you train up to be a high-capacity leader.
- Work with Next Steps Team to build the YTH Serve Team.

Pastoral

- Preparing messages weekly to preach the Gospel and the name of Jesus.
- Develop intentional relationships with students. Know their names, their stories, and be an example to them.
- Create an environment where any student can feel welcome while keeping Jesus the main focus of why we do ministry.
- o Follow up with care and crisis situations with your team and/or students.
- o Develop your team of leaders spiritually.

- o Build relationships with local schools and seek out opportunities to serve them.
- o Attend at least three or four school events (games, meets, etc) per school year.

Administrative

- Working with your team to ensure supplies and equipment for YTH are purchased and arrive in a timely manner.
- o Oversee systems for following-up with new team members and onboarding.
- Oversee any applicable budgets and ensure monthly spending is managed and on schedule for the year.
- Oversee church facilities and equipment used by YTH, ensuring it is organized and in proper working order.
- Respond to emails and phone call within 24-48 hour time frame during working hours.
- Help build systems to follow up with, engage, and carry out the vision for students so we can connect them to Jesus and help them live on Purpose.

Other

 Student ministry and ministry in general is a dynamic role - there may be things you are asked to do outside of your "department" from time-to-time. The ability to manage the tasks of helping your team while also getting your own work done is important.
